Adjudicator orders release of address information

An Adjudicator with the Office of the Information and Privacy Commissioner has ordered the Edmonton Police Service to disclose information it had severed from an access request.

An individual made a request for access to a record containing details of an incident in which she was involved that occurred in October 1983. The Public Body found a responsive record and provided it to her, but redacted portions of an address.

Adjudicator Teresa Cunningham found that the address was not personal information under the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act (FOIP), because it was not about an identifiable individual other than the Applicant. She ordered EPS to disclose the severed address information.
