Adjudicator determines College of Psychologists properly withheld information

An Adjudicator with the Office of the Information and Privacy Commissioner has determined the College of Psychologists properly withheld information under two sections of the *Personal Information Protection Act* (PIPA).

An individual made a request to the College for the response a Psychologist had provided to the College to a complaint the individual had made against the Psychologist to the College.

The College refused to provide the information under Section 24(2)(c) (information collected for an investigation or legal proceeding), and 24(2)(b) (information that would reveal personal information about another individual).

Adjudicator Christina Gauk found that the College had properly applied both sections of PIPA and upheld the College's decision not to release the information.
