Project Summary:

The APAS Society (ApplyAlberta) was created to develop and implement a web-based application system to provide students with easier access to essential information, services and admission to Alberta's colleges, universities and technical institutes. The organization is collaboration among Alberta's 21 public post-secondary institutions, with support from Alberta Advanced Education and Technology and Alberta Education.

APAS will allow applicants to apply to multiple post-secondary institutions and transfer their Alberta high school and post-secondary transcripts between institutions. The major focus of the system is to make it easier for applicants to enter the post-secondary system.

This PIA report identifies the privacy and security safeguards in place that will adequately protect the personal information involved.
