Project Summary:

The implementation of the Cerner Millennium Lab Information System/Radiology Information System (LIS/RIS) will provide enhancements to patient care, patient and staff safety, improved data quality, and business efficiencies. Among other capabilities in support of the e-record initiative, the LIS/RIS Project will:

- Allow real-time presentation of lab and radiology information and support of processes for both providers and consumers (improving quality)
- Enhance information and workflow linkages across the continuum of care
- Mitigate risks to avoid unintended or harmful outcomes

This project also includes the implementation of the Cerner Millennium Enterprise Scheduling Management system (ESM). This provides the ability to schedule Ambulatory patient appointments with associated clinics, physicians and resources. The benefits of the ESM include:

- Patients will receive an enhanced type of care at the right time from the right provider
- Patients will receive the right information and access to tools to support active participation in his/her personal care
