**Adjudicator orders Alberta Securities Commission to refund fees**

An Adjudicator with the Office of the Information and Privacy Commissioner has ordered the Alberta Securities Commission to refund the fees of an individual who had requested records from the Commission.

The Applicant requested that the Office of the Information and Privacy Commissioner to review whether the Securities Commission had met its duty to assist and had complied with time limits for responding.

The Adjudicator found that the Commission did not extend the time frame for responding under section 14 of the *Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act* (FOIP), and that it did not make reasonable efforts to respond under section 11 of the Act, but that it did meet its general duty to assist under section 10(1).

The Adjudicator ordered the Public Body to refund the Applicant's fee of \$64.50
