Commissioner rules Alberta Treasury Branches properly responded to an information request

The Office of the Information and Privacy Commissioner has ruled that Alberta Treasury Branches/ATB Financial did respond to an information request within the timelines of the *Personal Information Protection Act* (PIPA).

The matter went to inquiry when an Applicant filed a complaint after requesting records relating to her work performance and termination. The Applicant felt ATB had not processed her request within the allowed time limits.

The Commissioner determined that ATB had responded to the Applicant's request within the timeframe set out in the act, and after reviewing the records, confirmed the Organization's decision not to correct the Applicant's information.
