

YOU HAVE THE RIGHT TO...

- 1** KNOW WHY YOUR HEALTH INFORMATION IS COLLECTED
- 2** ASK FOR A COPY OF YOUR ALBERTA NETCARE RECORD
- 3** LIMIT ACCESS TO YOUR ALBERTA NETCARE RECORD
- 4** KNOW WHO HAS LOOKED AT YOUR INFORMATION IN ALBERTA NETCARE
- 5** ASK THAT ERRORS BE CORRECTED
- 6** ASK FOR AN INDEPENDENT REVIEW

WHAT IS ALBERTA NETCARE?

To help make decisions about your care quickly and efficiently, your health information is available through a province-wide electronic record system named Alberta Netcare, under the authority of the *Health Information Act*.

YOUR RIGHTS:

Consent to have your health information included in Alberta Netcare is **not required** by law, but **you** have **six rights** that allow you to exercise **privacy control**.
