Call for Nominations

Eligibility Criteria

The nominee has made a significant contribution to access to information in Alberta by:

- Developing innovative tools that promote or facilitate access to information
- Fostering a culture of openness and accountability through education and training programs that support or enhance access to information
- Demonstrating creativity in increasing public awareness on the right to access information
- Being a leader in promoting public access to information

How to Apply

Nominations must include a letter of nomination (max. 1,500 words) including the significance and impact of the nominee's activities in access to information.

Supporting materials may also be provided (e.g., letters of reference, news articles, product samples, etc.).

Nominations may be self-initiated or submitted by another person. Any nomination by another person must have the written consent of the nominee, included in the nomination package.

Contact information must be provided for the nominee and nominator. If the nominee is a group or entity, a contact person must be designated.

Repeat nominations are welcome.

Deadline for Nominations

Nomination packages must be received on or before **Monday, December 31, 2018**.
