



WHAT IS ALBERTA NETCARE?

To help make decisions about your care quickly and efficiently, your health information is available through a province-wide electronic record system named Alberta Netcare, under the authority of the *Health Information Act*.

YOUR RIGHTS:

Consent to have your health information included in Alberta Netcare is **not required** by law, but you have **six rights** that allow you to exercise **privacy control.**
